This year neither Grant nor I received a ticket in the lottery. Very few of our camp mates and none of the build team received tickets in the lottery either.

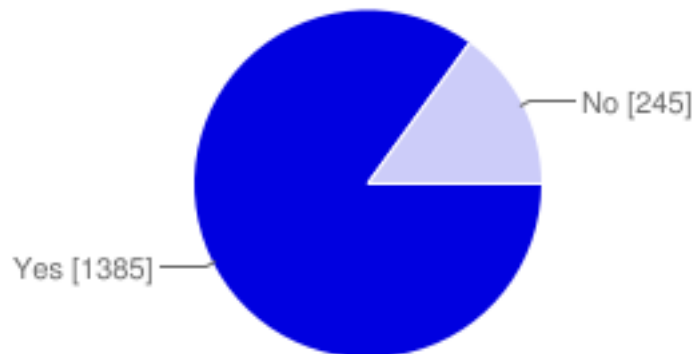

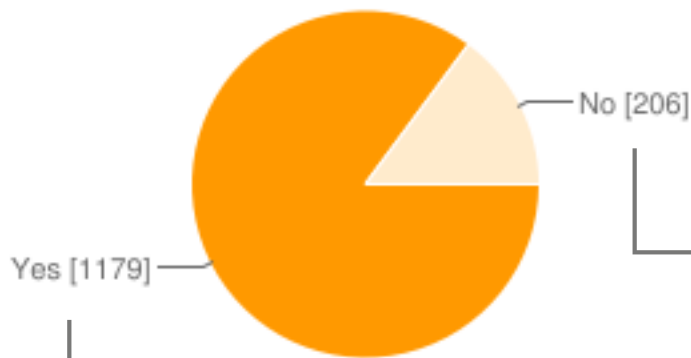

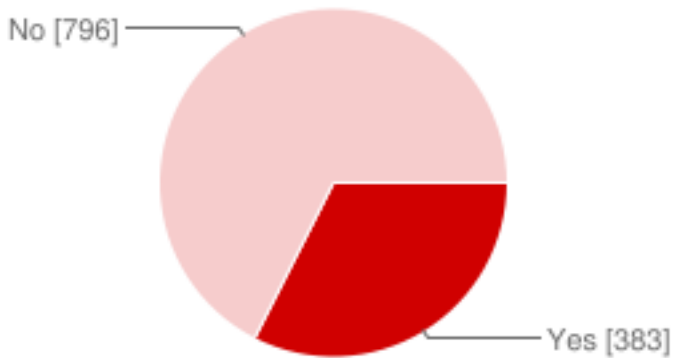

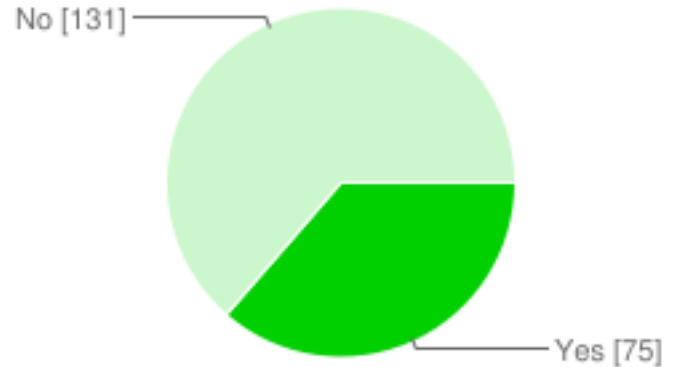
Have you been to Burning Man in years past?

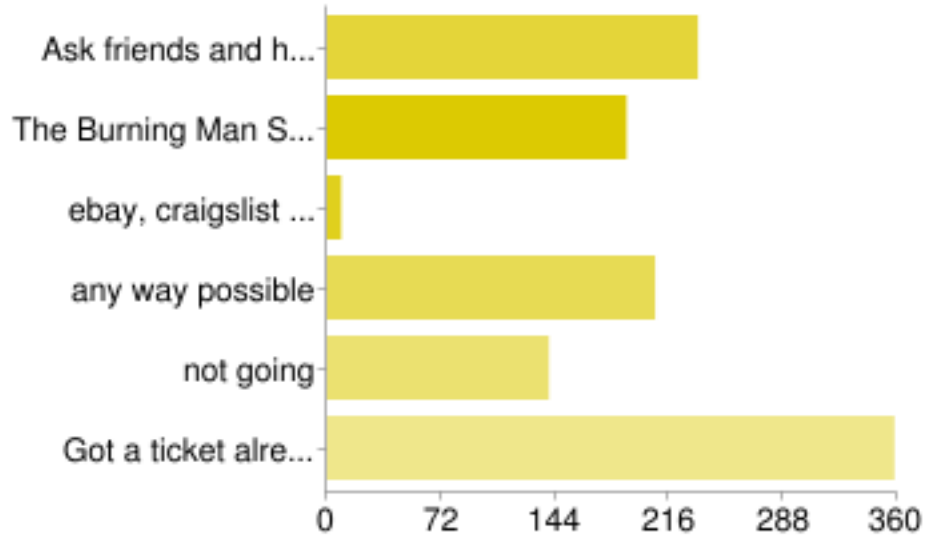

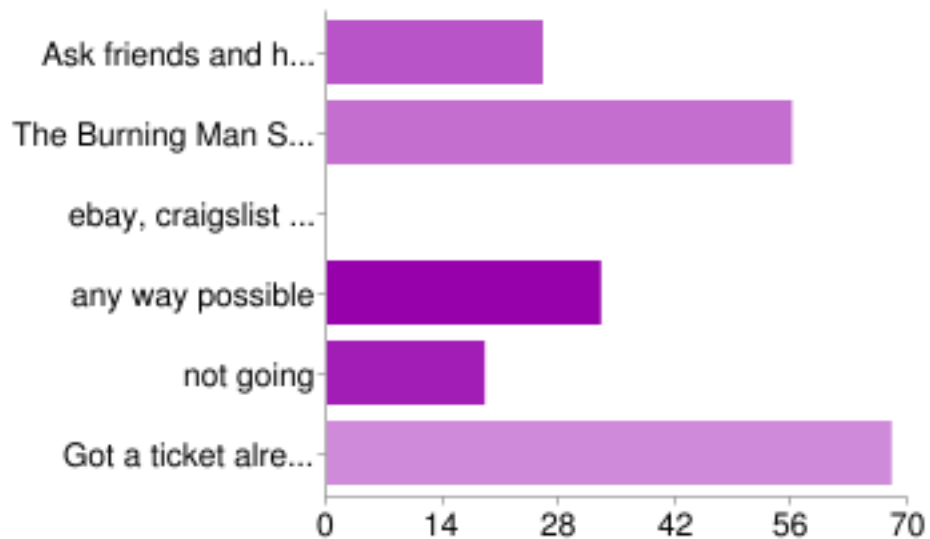
